The City of Toronto is carrying out a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study to assess the opportunity to consolidate thirty stormwater outfalls within the Etobicoke Waterfront Drainage Area that discharge stormwater directly to Lake Ontario. The goal of the study is to improve water quality by implementing stormwater management facilities in the study area. This project was identified in the City of Toronto's 2003 Wet Weather Flow Master Plan.

#### **We Would Like to Hear From You**

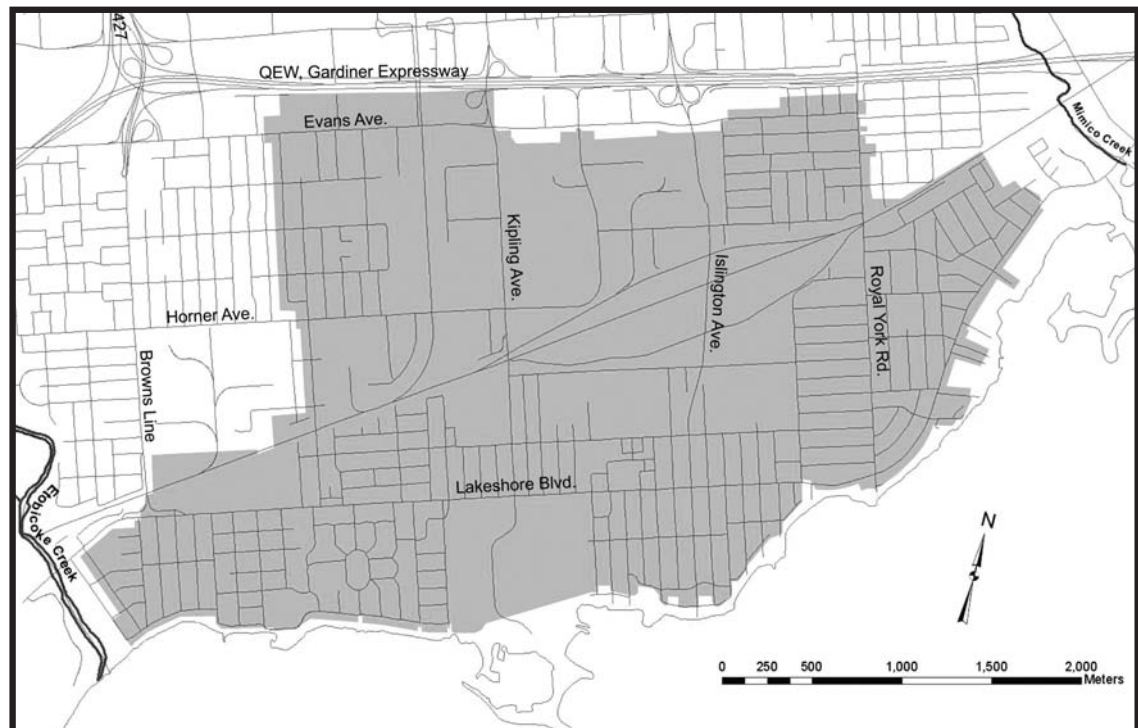
