The "Sherway Trail" is the missing link connecting the south portion of the Etobicoke Creek Trail with the area north of the QEW. This trail was expected to be completed in 2010 with Section 37 money secured in 2006 from the development at 700 Evans Avenue. Now that all the legal hurdles have finally been cleared, the city of Toronto has lost interest.

It's time to tell Ward 5 Councillor, Justin Di Ciano that it's important to you!

This trail extension will provide a vital safe, and convenient connection under the Queen Elizabeth Way for pedestrians and cyclists. This will facilitate access for Ward 6 residents to Sherway Gardens and for Ward 5 residents to Lake Ontario and the Waterfront Trail. It will also create an important link between the Waterfront Trail and Mississauga via the historic Middle Road Bridge.
