Project Information Letter

Phase 2 Overview

- Phase 2 aims to continue shoreline repair and protection work along the eastern park shoreline
- Phase 1 construction began in 2024 and is approximately 60% complete
- Phase 1 construction estimated complete in 2027
- Phase 2 construction anticipated to begin 2027 and estimated complete in 2029

Phase 2 Concepts

Work will focus on 3 eastern shoreline areas of Colonel Samuel Smith Park, and will include:

- Enhanced and expanded sand shoreline
- Enhanced and expanded cobble shoreline
- Construction of stacked armourstone wall with shoreline access stairs

Trail Impacts



Phase 2 work will use existing access and staging/stockpiling areas. This approach was chosen to:

- Reduce project costs
- Reduce project duration
- Reduce risks to public safety during material delivery
- Reduce potential tree removals and environmental impacts

The Project Team will continue to monitor access routes and trail closures for ways to minimize disruption to park users.
